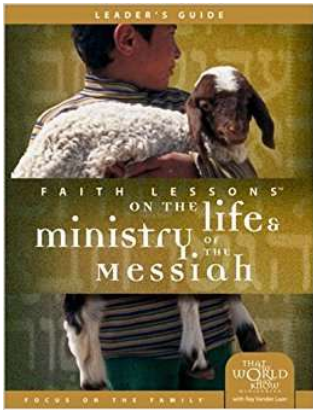




Wednesday evening classes are located throughout our campus, and vary in length and topic.

There will be no classes on Ash Wednesday, February 14th due to the Ash Wednesday service at 7:00pm



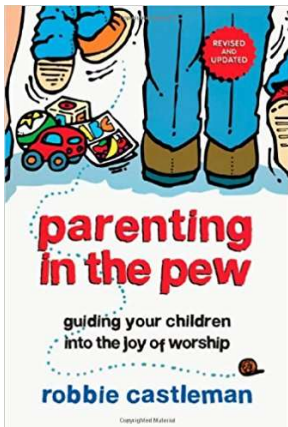
Life and Ministry of the Messiah by Ray Vander Lann

Book: Uninvited: *Living Loved When You Feel Less Than, Left Out and Lonely.* By Lysa TerKeurst.

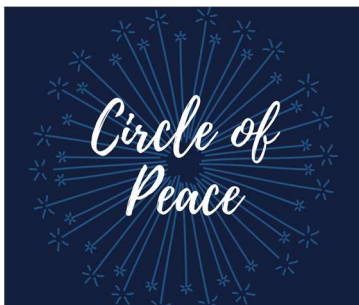
The enemy wants us to feel rejected . . . left out, lonely, and less than.
